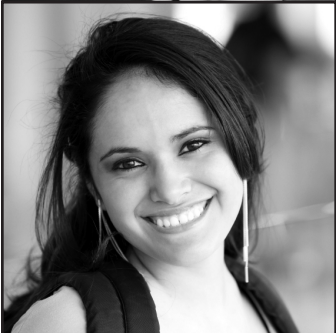

In 2010-2011 the Foundation's focus was on community. New programs were launched, friendships were made, and existing partnerships were strengthened, all with the common mission of providing economic support to the students, staff and programs of Northeast Metro 916 Intermediate School District.

The Foundation kicked off the 2010-2011 school year with a successful membership drive that raised over \$43,000 in contributions. We are grateful for the support and participation of Northeast Metro 916 staff, whose memberships increased 34% over the year before. During the membership drive the Foundation hosted its first 916 Retiree Breakfast with the purpose of celebrating the talented former district employees who made such an important impact in the educational experiences of students served by Northeast Metro 916. We also proudly recognized Gallagher & Associates, Inc. and HealthPartners for their participation in our new Business Partners Program.

Our annual programs were successful, with the Gala raising over \$22,000 and the 24th Annual Golf Tournament raising over \$18,000. But some of our events were also "friend-raisers," building important new ties in the district and community. In February 2011 we hosted our first Antiques and Arts Fair, partnering with Northeast Metro 916 staff and local businesses to offer a fun-filled day of antique appraisals, cartoon lessons, student art and a craft boutique. The Foundation also worked with the WELS-North and Transition programs to raffle two boats built by Northeast Metro 916 students. As the Foundation continues to build new relationships in the local community, we will host our first Spooky Family 5K Fun Run/Walk and Costume Parade on Saturday, October 15 at Lakewood Hills Park in White Bear Lake.

In addition to creating new and lasting relationships, the efforts of our programs and events help us raise funds to help make a difference in the lives of those we serve. In 2010-2011 the 916 Education Foundation's board of directors awarded over \$94,000 in scholarships, grants, and student and staff recognition.

We want to thank those of you who have made our efforts possible. It is through your generous contributions of time, talent and financial giving that we have been able to provide economic support to Northeast Metro 916's partnerships in special education, career and technical education, and a broad range of other educational services.
